<p>John 1:1-4</p> <p>Jesus is called "the Word" here. He has existed with God forever.</p>	<p>John 2:13-15</p> <p>There are many people in the temple selling things. Jesus chases them out!</p>	<p>John 3:5-6</p> <p>Jesus tells Nicodemus that all people must be born spiritually, or from above.</p>	<p>John 4:25-26</p> <p>A woman from Samaria learns that Jesus is the Messiah. (She's the first one ever!)</p>	<p>John 5:2-9</p> <p>Jesus heals a man who has been paralyzed for almost forty years.</p>	<p>John 6:16-21</p> <p>The disciples see Jesus walking on water on a stormy night.</p>	<p>John 7:37-38</p> <p>Jesus promises to bring new life (living water) to all those who truly want it and ask him for it.</p>
<p>John 8:12,31-32</p> <p>Jesus is the light of the world. Disciples stay in God's word and know the truth.</p>	<p>John 9:1-7</p> <p>Jesus heals a man who has been blind since birth.</p>	<p>John 10:11-15</p> <p>Jesus is the good shepherd. He will lay down his life for us.</p>	<p>John 11:4-44</p> <p>Jesus shows the glory of God by raising Lazarus, his friend, from the dead.</p>	<p>John 12:1-8</p> <p>Mary pours expensive perfume over Jesus as a sign of her devotion to him.</p>	<p>John 13:1-5</p> <p>Jesus washes the disciples' feet! He is being a servant to them.</p>	<p>John 14:15-17</p> <p>Jesus promises to send "an advocate" or helper. This is the Holy Spirit.</p>
<p>John 15:12-14</p> <p>Jesus is giving last instructions to his disciples before he is arrested.</p>	<p>John 16:16-18</p> <p>Jesus is trying to explain to the disciples that he will die and rise again.</p>	<p>John 17:1-5</p> <p>Jesus begins a long prayer for his disciples. Soon he will be arrested.</p>	<p>John 18:1-5</p> <p>Judas shows the soldiers where to find Jesus, so they can arrest him.</p>	<p>John 19:14-18</p> <p>Pilate and the religious leaders decide to crucify Jesus. Jesus dies.</p>	<p>John 20:1, 11-16</p> <p>The tomb is empty! Mary is sad until she learns that Jesus is alive!</p>	<p>John 21:4-7</p> <p>The disciples have gone back to their old lives - fishing. Jesus comes for them.</p>
